Notification is hereby given to the public of the intent of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to provide assistance to East Richland County Public Service District, for the repair of the Hunt Club road sewer pipe, located in Richland County, South Carolina, which was damaged in 2015 due to heavy rains and flooding.

Due to its location, this project is susceptible to future damages from flooding. Under the President's Executive Order 11988, Floodplain Management, FEMA is required to review the restoration of these facilities for opportunities to relocate it out of the floodplain or to minimize future damage from flooding. Public comment is invited on possible alternatives to these actions, methods to protect this facility and on whether this facility should be restored at all.
